To the best of our knowledge, we herewith confirm that the substances cadmium (Cd), lead (Pb), mercury (Hg), hexavalent chromium [Cr(VI)], polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE), bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP), butyl benzyl phthalate (BBP), dibutyl phthalate (DBP) and diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP), regulated by:

- the **Directive 2011/65/EU** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances (**RoHS**) in electrical and electronic equipment, as amended up to and inclusive of the Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2024/232,
- Annex II of **Directive 2000/53/EC** of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 September 2000 on end-of life vehicles (**ELV**) as amended up to and inclusive of the Commission Directive 2023/544,
